





1) Press 'Sound' tap and press 'Volume' tap,



 Adjust scroll bar left and right to set volume of section where you want to change

4.2.2 Touch sound



- 1) Press 'Sound' tap.
- 2) Press Toggle button of 'Touch sound' to set On/Off.

4.2.3 Ringtone



- 1) Press 'Sound' tap.
- 2) Press ringtone type you want to change.



- 3) Tap a ringtone to listen and select sound of bell
- 4) Press 'OK' button to save ringtone.








5.2 Wiring Diagram



Caution

- 1) In case of installing in the area where high voltage cable passes, use metal coaxial wire for wiring.
- If the wire inside is exposed by scratching the wire sheath, it may cause a short circuit, which may cause malfunction.
- 3) Turn off the monitor power switch when connecting the monitor to the camera.
- 4) Wiring between camera and monitor is polar.
- 5) Common entrance connecting cable 4-wire common method It is possible to connect to common entrance camera by using polarity.
