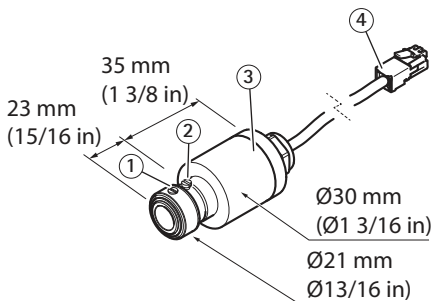

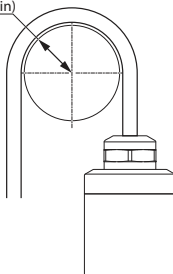


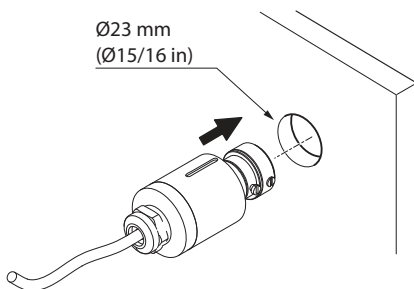

4. Camera connector

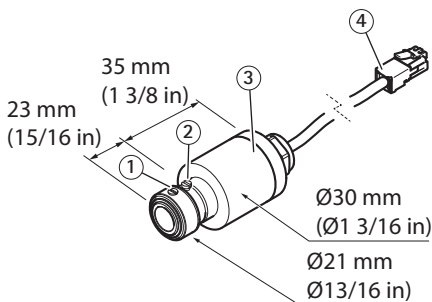
Min bending radius for cable

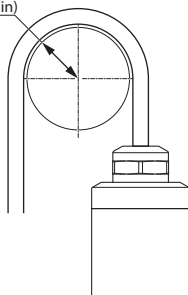


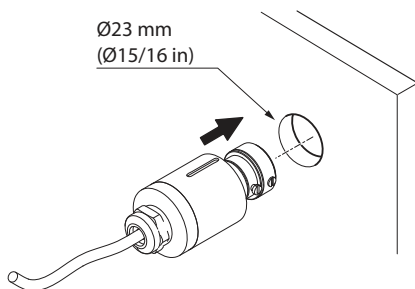

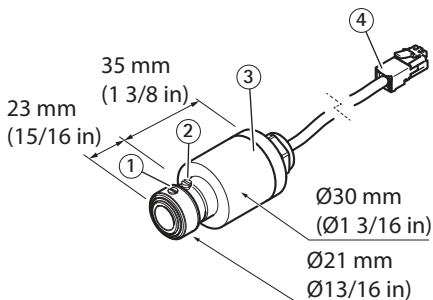

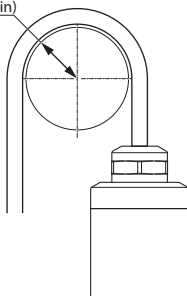

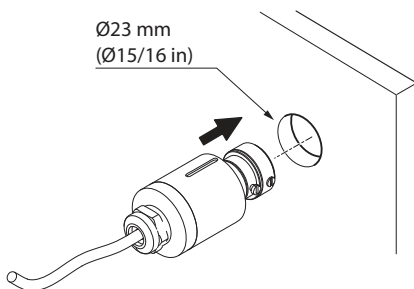

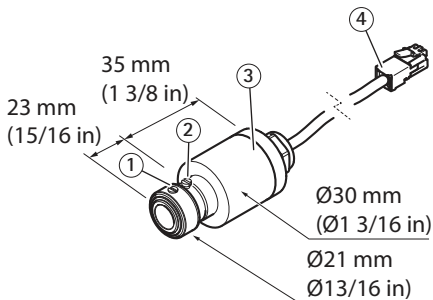

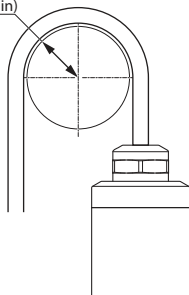

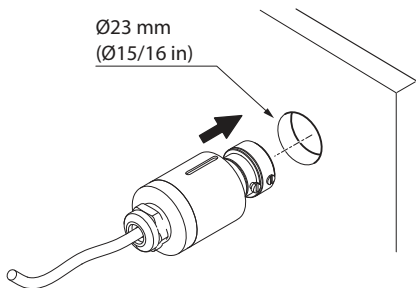

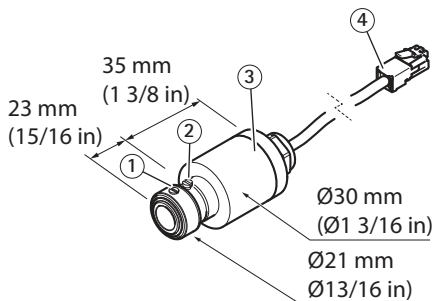

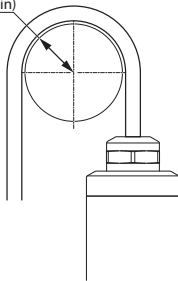
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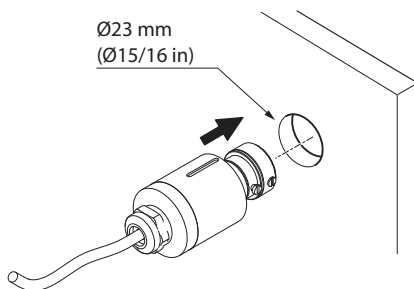

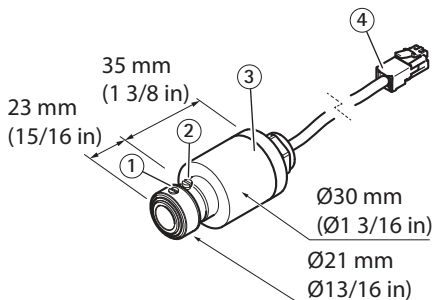
Radio mínimo de flexión del cable

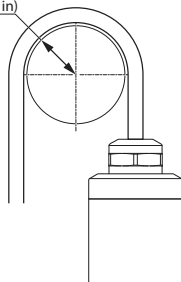
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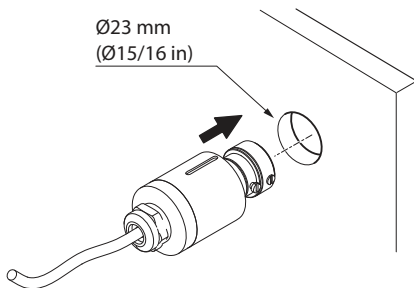


1. フォーカスの調節
